# The Greatest Show

- How do I find out in which show my dancer performs?
  - On the first bulletin board you'll see a print out that says something like "June Show Class Assignments"
  - There are three columns—one for each show.
  - Find your dancer's class(es) in one of the columns and match to your dancer's recital.
- What are the posters with costume pictures in the front windows?
  - We provide a sneak peek of costumes for most of our classes.
  - Underneath each picture you will find a caption with the class to which that costume corresponds.
  - Take a fun field trip with your dancer to find hers or his. :)
- What is home practice for recital dances?
  - Soon (if you haven't already) you will be receiving links to YouTube videos via email. These are videos of your dancer's class performing her or his dance.
  - Because we don't have the luxury of practicing every day, our home practice helps us better learn the sequence of the dance so class time can be spent on perfecting. :) I recommend practicing at least five times a week outside of class. It takes less than five minutes to practice once and you'd be surprised how much it helps!
- Show packets for Recitals
  - These come out this month!
  - This packet has all of the detail information you should need about recitals. Let us know if you have questions about it or don't receive it electronically by the end of March.
  - Forms: It includes two forms you may want to take advantage of.
    - Flower forms - if you're like to pre-order flowers from Pamela's Flowers there is a form included in the show packet. If you pre-order, your flowers will be ready for you at the theater the day of the show. They have a stand set up as well to purchase on site. These are not required. If you'd like flowers ordered, those forms will be due April 25th.
    - Advertising Forms - Our Keepsake Program is a wonderful place to advertise as simply encouragement for your dancer or for your business. Thousands of people attend our recitals and see your advertisement. Ad forms are also due on April 25th
    - We will remind you of both of these next month. Just want you to have the information if you like to plan ahead.
- Costumes
  - We will begin distributing costumes this month. You will receive an email to notify you specifically about each class. In addition to the costume itself, you will receive tights necessary for your dancer.
  - Please plan to be present for the last 10 minutes of class during costume as we try on costumes.
  - You will also receive a link to information about hair and tights for the costumes.
- 5 & 10 Year Dancer and Trophy Winners
  - Please notify us if it is your dancer's fifth or tenth year of dance at The Studio. This is a major accomplishment which we need to celebrate!

  - **\*\*Also, please start gathering any old photos you might want in an ad for your dancer, NOW!\*\*** Either prints or downloads will need to be purchased to use photos from previous years.

- Recital Backstage Volunteers

For each class we ask for 2 - 3 parent volunteers to help dancers prepare back stage during the recital. Volunteers assist the dancers and are able to watch from the wings.
