2019 - 2020 Dance Season!!

Hard to believe it's this time of year-it has been such a pleasure to have all of our dancers!

On Thursday you'll be receiving an email with your dancer's pre-approved classes for next year. This year our Early Registration discount period is until May 25. If you would like to register your dancer for the fall 2019 - 2020 season during this time, your registration is free! How this works: You either go online and choose from your dancer's pre-approved classes or work with us to do so at the desk, and pay the \$30 automatically charged registration fee. When your dancer begins in the fall, we will issue a full \$30 credit to your account!

Placements are a large undertaking. If we missed something or your dancer is interested in a genre you don't see, by all means check in with us! Final Payments & Show Tickets

Costume differences, recital fees and any final charges have been added to all accounts. If you have questions about this, login online or check in with Ms. Vicki. All money owed for the year is due now. Tickets for the June shows go on sale, Monday, 5/13, at 9am. All accounts must be paid in full for the year in order to purchase tickets. AUDITIONS: Performing Groups, Competition Teams, Contemporary Video Camp

As we provide our dancers new ways to grow, we continue to offer our Studio Company opportunities – Performing Groups, Competition Teams, and the Ballet Company. These, along, with our professionally staged ballets and recitals allow our dancers a real variety of performance opportunities.

If you'd like your dancer to join us in these endeavors come out for auditions on May 11th. Auditions for our performing groups are a good experience for our dancers, and are not competitive.

- Performing groups perform at events such as The Pennsboro PumpkinFest, Senior Centers, Senators games (July 19th this year!), local community showcases, or Hershey Park.
- Competition Teams compete in at least two weekend competitions and participate in one adjudicated dance conventions as well.
- The Ballet Company performs in our professionally staged ballets. Our next ballet is Spring 2020 and auditions will be in September.
- Participation in these groups comes with additional class requirements for both summer and fall. If you would like to be in The Studio Company, see the Company Handbook at the desk (which will be updated before auditions.)
- Auditions will be based on genre of interest this year.

We are thrilled to offer these opportunities to our dancers. I sincerely hope you share in our enthusiasm!
